

WLLID Program Report 2014/15

Communication

During the 2014/15 year Trustees continued to place a high priority on improving communication with the members of the WLLID. The newsletter is distributed monthly and monthly contributions are submitted to the Tri-village Buzz. Some other approaches have also been undertaken.

The first of these was the development of a website (www.wasalake.ca). The website is regularly updated with information pertaining to the District. Posted on it are minutes of the regular Board meetings, newsletters, and by-laws, policies and procedures that have recently been approved. You will also find photographs of sites around the lake taken by members of the community. All contributions are welcome. If you have items for the website please send them to admin@wasalake.ca.

Notices for board meetings are also posted on community bulletin boards at least two weeks prior to each meeting.

We continue to encourage you to provide us with your email address if applicable. Currently the newsletter is emailed to 187 subscribers, about one-half of the number of owners. We would like to be able to contact all members of the district by email (if you have it) and encourage you to contact us with any concerns or comments you have. We will respond to any and all comments.

An introduction/information package is now mailed to all new property owners.

Trustees also established a position to be filled by an owner whose residence lies outside BC. As BC law prohibits non-residents from voting on the WLLID the person filling this liaison/advocate position will be expected to bring the concerns of those owners to the attention of the Trustees and to assist the Trustees in their attempts to maintain communication with those owners, of which there are many. The position has yet to be filled and we look forward to receiving applications.

We expect that communication will continue to receive a great deal of attention from the Board in the coming year.
