Dear Property Owners: Cooler evenings and a bit of rain have helped to reduce the possibility of wildfire, but the summer is not over yet. There are still plenty of sunny days ahead.

Milfoil Update

Trustees have made arrangements to perform an aerial survey of lake vegetation, particularly Native Milfoil. The information collected will establish how much vegetation is actually in the lake, so that growth can be monitored to determine if it increases or declines over time. Watch for the drone flying low over the lake sometime during the week of September 11-15. It will fly in the early hours of the day when the water is calm.

Shoreline Clean Up

Trustees will once again participate in the Great Canadian Shoreline Clean Up on October 14. This year we intend to expand the clean up beyond the lakeshore and into the community, and we are inviting all other groups to join us. It will be an opportunity to demonstrate in action how much we care about our community.
