FIRE BAN

As of Wednesday, June 30, all campfires and category 2 and category 3 fires are banned throughout British Columbia. Also banned are fireworks, burn barrels, tiki torches, chimineas, and outdoor stoves or other portable campfire apparatus without a rating from Canadian Standards Association (CSA) or Underwriters Laboratories of Canada (ULC). TAXES

Tax notices were mailed to property owners the first week of June and are due on July 15. Taxes unpaid after July 15 are subject to a 10% penalty and further charges over time as long as the bill remains overdue. Reminders and new invoices cost administration time and postage to prepare and the Improvement District would rather not have to take that route.
