Thanks to Covid-19, 2020 was memorable in ways that everyone hopes will never be repeated. Like everyone else, the trustees tried to make the best of things and carry on business as close to normal as possible. The four board members contributed over 144 volunteer hours to the community working on water testing and measuring, repair of the data logger, and tracking and reporting on the spring freshet, to name just a few of their responsibilities.

A record number of land title changes occurred in 2020; 23 properties within the WLLID boundary changed hands in 2020 and 8 new lots were subdivided from a larger property,

After a 7 month delay, the Ministry of Community, Sport, and Culture (whose jurisdiction includes improvement districts in BC) gave us permission to hold our Annual General Meeting on December 2, with strict adherence to precautionary measures to prevent the spread of Covid. The trustees reported on the year's activities and an election was held for two positions. Nowell Berg was re-elected for his 3rd term and we gained a brand new trustee, Tom Braumandl. Congratulations to both!
