Although the usual trash can still be found on the shoreline every year, generally we are finding that after 4 years of annual cleanup, the amount is declining. The most common items found are food wrappers, cigarette butts, and plastic bits. We are, however, finding an increase of Styrofoam fragments that are breaking off of aging docks and washing up on shore. If you are a dock-owner, please inspect your dock and repair or replace it if it is deteriorating.

We would like to acknowledge the support of BC Parks for providing after-cleanup pizza for all the participants. All in all, it was a great sunny afternoon for a walk on the beach!
