

## REPORT TO AGM RE: WEEDS

- Received call regarding Eurasian milfoil weeds in lake
- In reaction to call took samples of weed into MOE
- Had Alana Ostrich conduct on site inspection with 3 board members
- Reviewed weeds in weed bed on south end of lake and near centre of lake east of Hanson Channel
- Confirmed that the weed was in fact a northern native milfoil which could have some environmental value to the health of the lake.
- However it could be spread by props from boats cutting the milfoil weed and allowing it to re seed
- So what can be done
- WLLID has purchased a GPS to map the size of the weed beds and also to determine if there is any growth. This monitoring will start soon.
- Alana Ostrich suggested that perhaps the weed beds became more prominent due to low water levels and warmer temperatures.
- We understand that Wasa Lake may be monitored this year by the Aquatic Invasive species council.
